

District Goals from 2015-2018 PDP approved plan:

1. Increase student achievement in all curriculum areas for all students
2. Increase graduation rate to meet and/or exceed NYS graduation requirements
3. Implement Common Core Standards
4. Utilize data driven instructional strategies

District Targets for 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years:

- A. Increase graduation rate by 3% (to 85%).
- B. Increase percentage of students reading at or above grade level by **at least 10%, aiming for a minimum of 50% at each grade level.**
- C. Increase proficiency on all NYS assessments by 5%. *(For Regents exams with 85%+ proficiency last year, our goal is to maintain that percentage +/- 5%)*
- D. Decrease course failures by 10% compared to same quarter of previous year
- E. Decrease number of students with 18 or more absences by 10%
