2020-21 Proposed Budget Remains Under Property Tax Cap

Due to a recently enacted executive order from Governor Cuomo, the process for school district budget votes, and the election of school board members, has changed.

This year all eligible voters will be sent an absentee ballot and return addressed envelope (postage included) along with this newsletter to conduct their vote. The absentee ballot and return envelope need to be filled out, signed, and sent back to the return address to cast your vote on the 2020-21 budget, school bus purchase and board of education members. The ballots need to be received by the District no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9.

The 2020-21 proposed budget, which has a decrease of \$34,219 (or 0.08 percent) under the current year's budget, will result in a tax levy increase of 1.9 percent.

The tax levy increase falls well below the New York State property tax cap of 3.4 percent for the District. Additionally, voters will also elect two members to the Board of Education and vote on a proposition to purchase four school buses.

The budget accounts for increases in health insurance premiums, contractual salary obligations, transportation contracts, TRS employer contributions, and two new special education classrooms to meet upcoming IEP requirements. It also provides for programs and services that will be necessary to assist students and staff with their transition back into the school setting.

Hudson Falls Central School District will save money through twelve retirements, a returning special education placement, renegotiated service contracts, a reduction in BOCES services, and lower bond principal and interest payments.

2020-21 Three-Part Budget Summary

Administrative expenditures cover expenses related to district management. The Administrative expenses comprise **9.69**% of the overall budget.

Program expenditures include items directly related to instruction. These include salaries, benefits, and transportation. The Program budget comprises approximately 72.50% of the total budget.

Capital expenditures account for 17.81% of the total budget. They include the cost of maintenance, operation, utilities, transportation, and debt service. Central Services, under both the Administrative and Program components, include the cost of copiers, central printing and mailing, and central data processing.

Building projects allow the District to address facilities' needs that would otherwise not be possible without the offsetting revenue. Thanks to the support of the community, the District has been able to leverage our Building Aid to offset the increase in the Capital component of the budget.



The purpose of this vote is to elect two members to the Board of Education, for a term of five years. Also to vote on the budget and a transportation proposition.

HOW TO VOTE

- 1. Mark in pen or pencil.
- 2. To vote, make a single cross mark (X) or a single check mark (✓) in the voting square.
- 3. To vote for a person whose name is **not** printed on this ballot, write his or her name in the blank space **above** the candidate's name as a "write-in" candidate.
- Any other mark or any erasure on this ballot is unlawful.
- 5. Fold and place your ballot in the enclosed "ballot" envelope, seal it, and sign the back where indicated.

NOTE: YOU MUST SIGN THE VOTER STATEMENT ON THE BACK SIDE OF THE ENVELOPE.

Enclose it in the large envelope addressed to the School District Clerk and mail it.
